



Lions Emblem installed at St John Headquarters



In recognition of a \$60,000 donation by Sydney Chinese Lions, St John (NSW) recently installed a plaque at their Communications Room inside St John House, their new Headquarters in Burwood.

The Communications Room, dubbed the nerve centre of their life-saving capabilities, is one of the key facilities at the St John Headquarters.



On 14 July 2012, members of the Board of Directors of Sydney Chinese Lions were invited to visit the facility. The Lions were warmly received by Maj Gen (rtd) Warren Glenny, Deputy Chair of the St John Board, Mr Brett Murray, Mr Huw Price and others. The visitors were shown the Communications Room where the plaque is displayed as well as some of the vehicles that St John employs for field operations.

To date, Sydney Chinese Lions have donated over \$100,000 to St John (NSW). Their first donation was made in 2007 when they donated an amount of \$41,000. On that occasion, in recognition of the Lions' contributions, a brand new ambulance bearing the Lions' emblem was named after the Club.
