History fast tracks to April 1995, Sydney. A group of Chinese Australians, out of the love for the country and community that they lived in, determined to uphold the common motto of "We Serve" of Lions and founded the first ever Chinese-based Lions club in Australia - Sydney Chinese Lions Club.

Over the past 27 years, Sydney Chinese Lions have raised and donated close to AUD \$1 million much needed funds to a good number of charities including the Royal Flying Doctors, St John Ambulance, CareFlight, Australian Red Cross, Lions Clubs International Foundation and others.

Under the leadership of Dr Anthony Cheung OAM, Sydney Chinese Lions raised and donated AUD\$40,000 to Lions Clubs International Foundation in 2020 to help solve some of the urgent problems humanity is facing, like life threatening diseases and diabetes.

As the Membership Chair and Board Director of Sydney Chinese Lions, I'm very proud to announce that our Club, with some 70 members strong and 6 Past International Presidents of Lions as our Associate Members, has recently been awarded the Campaign 100 Model Club by Lions Club International Foundation.

Sydney Chinese Lions Club has been recognised as "leaders among leaders" and they are "an example for all clubs".

In recognition of his dedicated service to Australia and the community over the past decades, PDG Dr Anthony Cheung, President of Sydney Chinese Lions Club was awarded the Medal of The Order of Australia (OAM) in June 2021 by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the approval of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth The Second, Queen of Australia and Sovereign of the Order of Australia.

Today, for us Sydney Chinese Lions members, these recent recognitions only mark the beginnings of a renewed dedication in serving our community.
