## CHINESE LIONS CHINESE MEDICINE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

## The Lions Club of Sydney Chinese is pleased to offer a competitive scholarship to a University of Technology, Sydney (UTS) postgraduate student undertaking research in the area of Traditional Chinese Medicine.

The scholarship of \$2000 will be awarded each year from 2011 to 2013 (three times). The scholarship will be determined by a panel of two academics from UTS and 2 nominated member of the Sydney Chinese Lions. The panel may decide to split the award if two applications are of equal quality or not to award the scholarship if there are no quality applications

The application will include:

- Cover page stating why the student is applying for the scholarship, their career goals and how the scholarship will assist the achievement of these goals.
- The project proposal (3 pages max)

Students are eligible to apply will if they are:

- enrolled in a PhD or Masters by Research (full or part time) and
- have not previously been awarded the scholarship

Applications will close 31<sup>st</sup> March each year and a decision will be made by mid April. Funds will be used to support the living expenses of the student. The student will be required to present to the Sydney Chinese Lions club on their project at the completion of the scholarship year

In providing this award the Sydney Chinese Lions acknowledge the benefit to the community of research being done in the field and the role of UTS as a city campus located close to Chinatown.

The UTS will advertise the scholarship and provide an invitation to a member of the Sydney Chinese Lions to present the award at the annual Faculty of Science Prize Giving ceremony usually held in May each year.
